

2009 Rumbles and E-Rumbles Submittal Guidelines

Rumbles

Rumbles is the member publication of the Rocky Mountain Section of the American Water Works Association and the Rocky Mountain Water Environment Association. This publication provides information and material related to the water and wastewater industry of the Rocky Mountain region. We encourage submittals to publish technical articles, news of interest, letters to the editor, and other select, general news.

Rumbles reserves the right to reject any and all submissions. Accepted submittals are subject to editing for length, clarity, and style. Unacceptable article materials include those without bylines, incorrect or questionable technical accuracy, material written or reads as ad copy (unless it is a paid ad) and press releases. Unsolicited articles deemed to be acceptable may be published on a space-available basis.

All articles, tables, graphs and photos are to be submitted electronically (e-mail preferred) to respective editors a minimum of 60 days prior to publication. Submitted files must be in Microsoft Office format (*.txt, *.doc, or *.rtf) and must be accessible for editing. Read-only files (e.g. Adobe PDF), encrypted, or password-protected files will be returned.

Feature Article: Approximately 1,500 words (single spaced, 12 point, Times New Roman font) are recommended for the feature article. Send all tables as separate files, Microsoft Office format (*.xls or *.doc) tables only. All graphs & figures must be submitted separately in bitmap (*.bmp) or TIFF (*.tif) format.

Photos: Submit photographs in one of the following electronic formats: TIFF (*.tif), bitmap (*.bmp), or high resolution JPEG (*.jpg). Photos of insufficient resolution, or larger than 6 MB, will be rejected. All photos must be submitted in electronic format only.

E-Rumbles

E-Rumbles will not publish articles. *E-Rumbles* is a document of links to articles published on various websites. The intent of *E-Rumbles* is to provide a map, if you will, to website locations announcing seminars, awards, and other items of interest.

Submittals should be maximum of 30 words with an appropriate, specific, website address to hyperlink (generic website addresses such as rmsawwa.net will not be accepted). All submittals to *E-Rumbles* need to be submitted to the respective RMSAWWA or RMWEA websites, or some other appropriate website, PRIOR to being submitted to *E-Rumbles* (remember, we will publish the LINK to an article that is already published somewhere else on the web).

Be sure to test the link you are referencing BEFORE submitting to us. Submittals with links in error are in danger of not being published. All website addresses will be verified prior to publication. Submittals without a website address will be published only at the editor's discretion.

Deadline: Deadline for *E-Rumbles* submittals is the 25th of the month prior to publication. For example, publication in the February issue (to be e-mailed February 1) requires submittal by January 25.

Submittal to the RMSAWWA or RMWEA websites deadline is the 20th of the month prior to allow for posting and obtaining of a website address.
